The "Free Tuition" waiver is available to all GED Students who live in the South Suburban College District with the following restrictions...

- ❖ Only one free course per student is allowed.
- ❖ You must bring a copy of the paid receipt for the GED Test/or an official copy of the GED transcript to the Admissions Office as proof of eligibility.
- ❖ You must complete the Placement Test prior to registration. (Except for P-E)
- ❖ You must live in Community College District #510.
- ❖ This offer is only available for 100 level and above courses and does not apply to NAS 100 or PHB 100.
- ❖ This offer applies to tuition only. You must pay for your books and fees for the course you select.
- ❖ This form must be signed by an SSC counselor.
- ❖ Courses are subject to availability.
- ❖ This waiver is not valid when used in conjunction with Federal and/or State Financial Aid.
- ❖ This waiver should be used within one year of the successful completion of the GED test.
